5K COURSE- The course is the classic or older of the UW-Parkside 5000 meter courses.

All 2026 high school meets will be run on this course.

We allow an unlimited number of runners to participate in each of the races, however only the First **SEVEN** finishers from each school will count for team scoring. Varsity runners do not need to be declared. The top seven finishers from your team will automatically become the varsity.

Teams that do not submit their rosters by the entry deadline will be assessed a ~~\$25.00~~ late fee which must be paid race day. **Late entries** must be submitted on the downloadable excel XC roster form on the Wisconsin Runner homepage www.wisconsinrunner.com . Simply download the form, save it to your computer (include your school name in the file title), complete and save the form and then email it to: wisrun@gmail.com.

Timing: Wisconsin Runner will be timing and scoring for the meet using the Race Result disposable chip system in conjunction with Finish Lynx **Ether Lynx Photo Finish** and **Identi Lynx Video** Cameras.

Results will be posted to the Wisconsin Runner website during the meet.

On Monday night prior to the meet a meet start list, as well as general meet information and updates, will be posted to the WR website.

At that time please make any additions or subtractions to your rosters for the meet.

PARKING: All participants & spectators should come in on Highway E and then turn left onto HY JR to access the UW-Parkside Physical Education or Communication Arts parking lots located off of Hwy JR east of the course. There is no participant drop off on Highway JR. No parking is allowed in any of the Petrifying Springs parking lots – this includes participants, coaches and spectators. Handicap Parking (with Permit) is allowed in the lot immediately North of the course on HY JR.

SPECTATORS: The admission fee per spectator is \$3.00 for 17 & Under, Adults & Seniors and \$5.00

SITE PROCEDURES: Teams (participants, alternates, coaches, trainers and managers) must enter the meet site together. When an athlete leaves the facility, they will not be allowed to re-enter the site.

TENTS & GROUND TARPS are allowed.

There is a large “Athletes Only” area behind the finish line area. This area is restricted to competing athletes, coaches and officials. This is where athletes leave their gear bags and water bottles.

All warmups and cool down running **MUST** be done on the Parkside course. Athletes should be in the designated team area when they are not warming up, racing or cooling down.
